



## Jason's Necklace



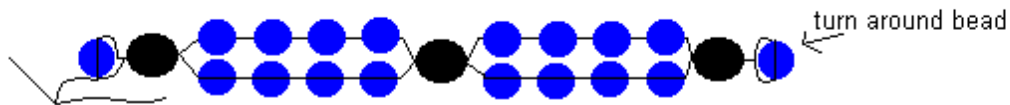
You will need....E beads with large holes or any large holed bead for spacers.....2 complimentary colors of 11o beads. bead tips and a clasp

- 1: Thread your needle with enough thread to equal 4 times the length of your necklace plus 8-10 inches for weaving and tying the tails back in.
- 2: thread on a stopper bead with a hole large enough to accept 4 passes of thread....1 bead tip....start stringing the necklace with 1 large bead.... 4 11o's.....1 large....4 11o's.....till you have the length you want ending with 1 large bead.
- 3: thread on a bead tip and 1 11o go back thru the bead tip and the 1st large bead.

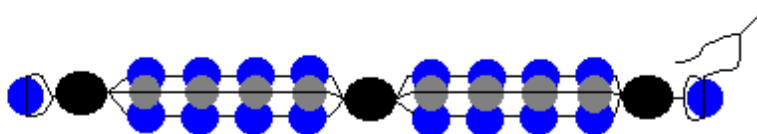


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- 4: add 4 11o's and go thru the next large bead....add 4 more 11o's and go thru the next large bead.....continue this to the end of necklace .....go thru bead tip and turn around bead....back thru beadtip and 1st large bead.



- 5: now it's time to change colors.....string on 4 11o's in your second color choice....go thru the next large bead....add 4 11o's.....go thru next large bead.....continue this to end of necklace....go thru bead tip and turn around bead.....and 1st large bead.



- 6: now you add 4 11o's and go thru the next large bead....but....make sure you line you new row up to go between the two rows of the contrasting color... that way you will have 4 rows of beads with each row a constrasting color.

**NOTE:** You need to keep your tension very very loose when doing the above steps ..otherwise you will end up with kinks!.....another way to do this would be to cut 4 lengths of thread....tie them together with a large knot to be hidden in a beadtip.....then string each row on a seperate thread and tie a knot on the other end to be hidden in a beadtip.

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
